Food for thought

- **75.000** M € can be saved through better implementation of EU lex
- 40.000 M € available in the recycling business
- 500.000 jobs available (recycling)
- 200.000 newborns/day in the world
- 16.000 kg resources used per capita/year (6.000 kg = waste)
 - 525 kg municipal waste per capita/year
 - 180 kg of food waste per capita/year
- 80/20 the most unfair and unsustainable ratio in the world
 - 40 % efficiency of a ton of carbon to produce electricity
 - 17 MS still bury more than 50% of their waste.
 - 15 % efficiency of a litre of petrol to produce driving energy


% of the 17 rare earth are recycled in the EU


Growing Resource Use








Resource productivity vs. Competitiveness

Municipal Solid Waste



Waste management hierarchy







Member States shall:

- Design appropriate Waste Management Plans (ongoing) & Waste Prevention Programmes (by December 2013)
- Promote re-use of products & preparation for reuse (re-use and repair networks)
- Take waste prevention measures (eco-design, economic instruments)
- Promote high quality recycling through separate collection of waste (PAYT) (by 2015)
- → Meet the recycling targets: 50% MSW 70% C&DW (by 2020)
- → Where recovery not undertaken, safe disposal





The Commission shall:

- Screen WMP and WPP (as of 2013)
- Deliver compliance assitance seminars in 10 MS (ongoing)
- WFD Lex conformity-checked (ongoing)
- Produce waste management modelling (ongoing)
- Review EU waste targets (in 2014)
- Push for ex-ante conditionalities (EU co-funding period 2014-2020)
