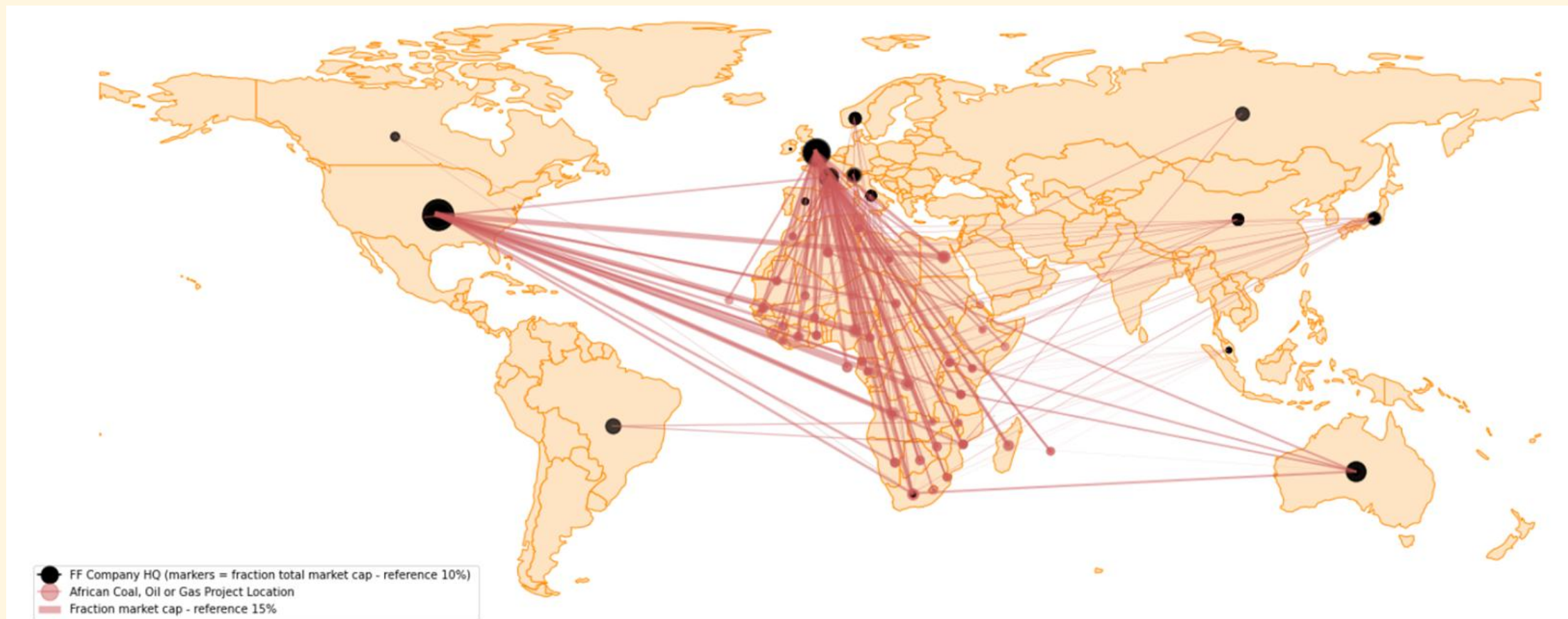


CLIMATE CHANGE: As Carbon budget shrinks, demands for justice increase

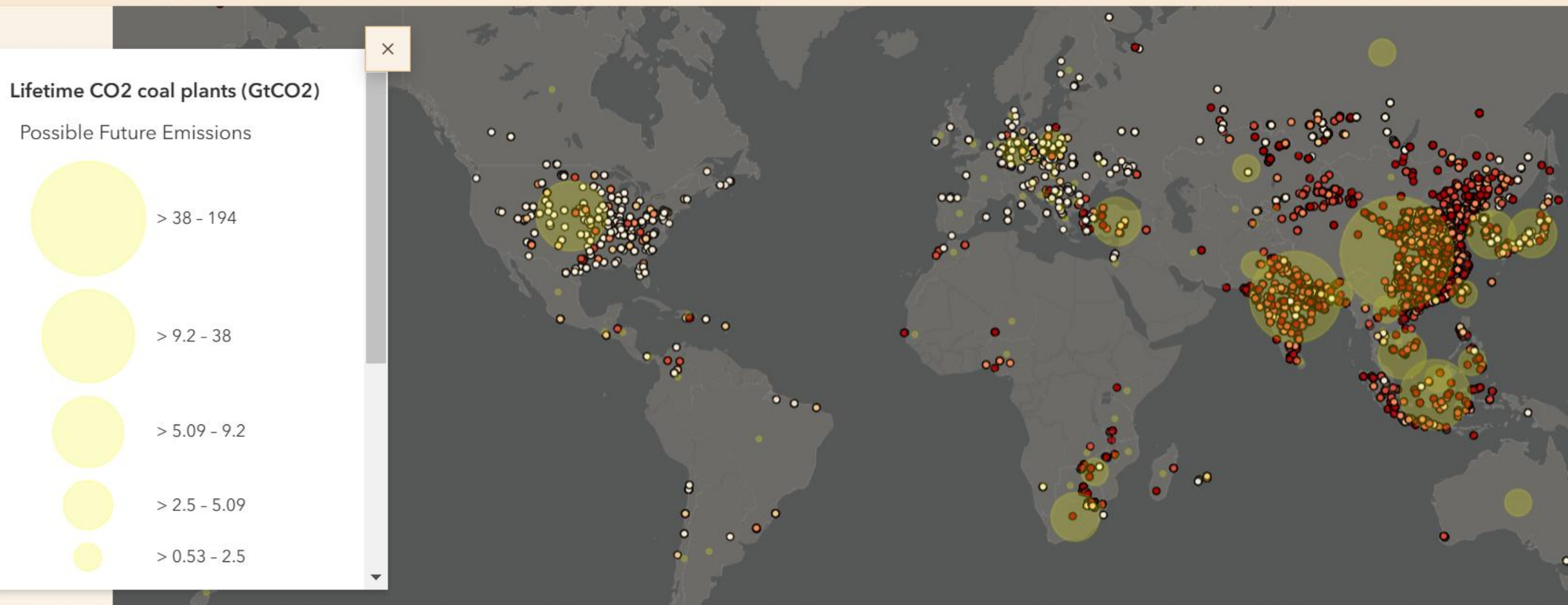




Links between 29 of the world's largest coal, oil and gas exploration & production firms (with HQ in black) & their African fossil fuel projects (red markers).



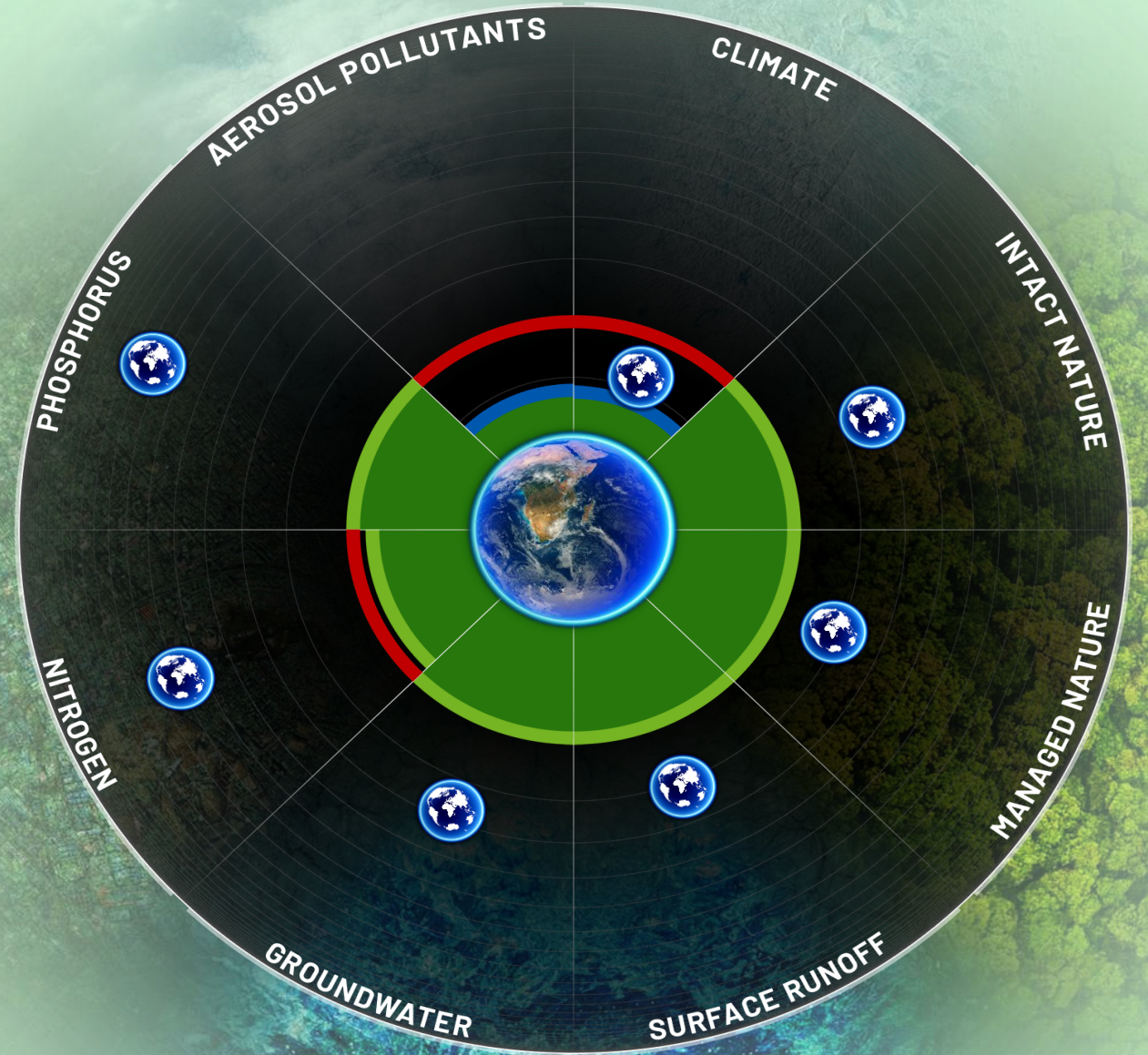
Lifetime of coal mines: closing coal in China and India is more than their annual GDP; we waited with our target, so that it matches the closure of our coal plants

Addressing Nature

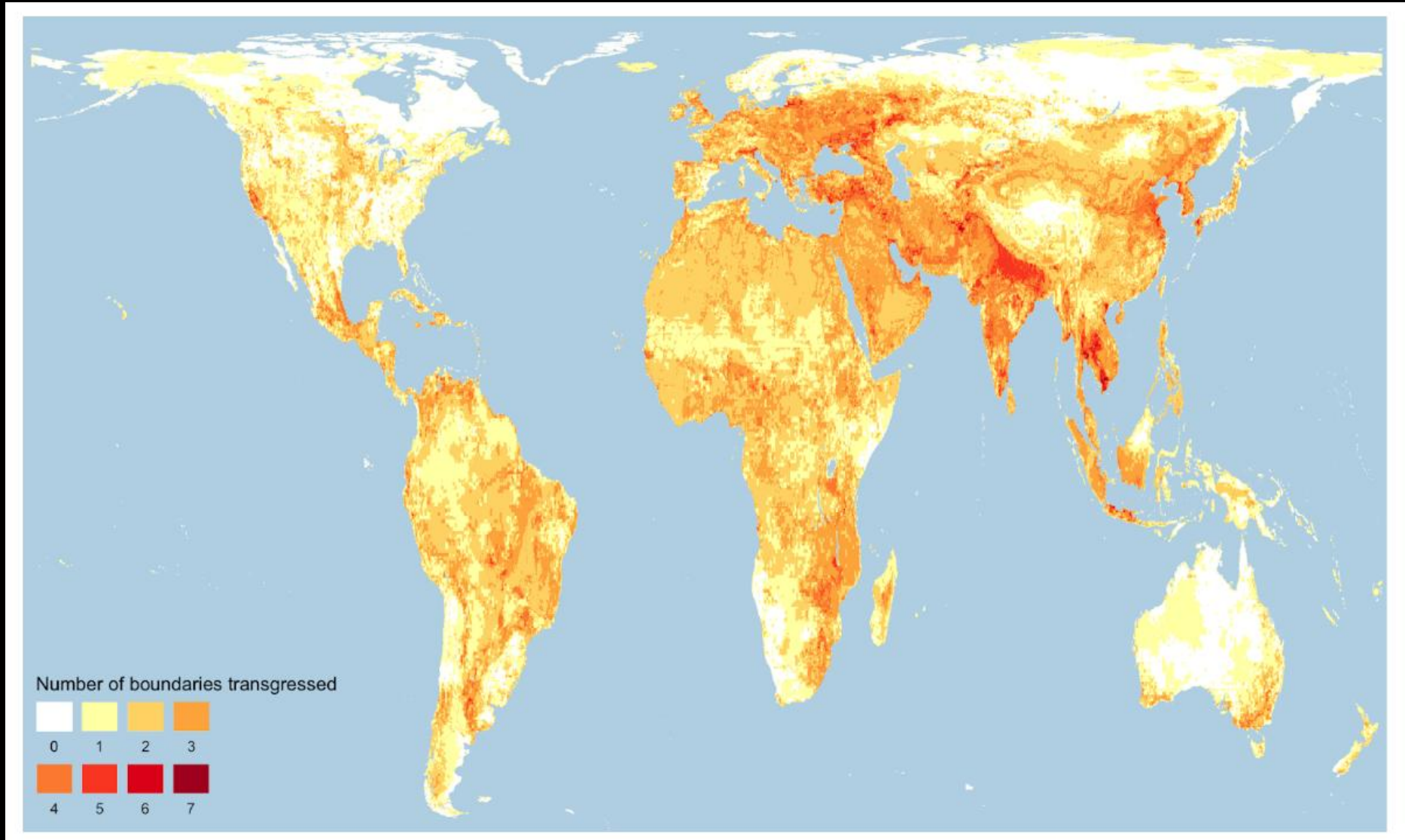
- Intact Nature: principle of returning land to nature from 45% to 50-60%.
- Integrity: Every square kilometre of managed land should have local diverse greenery.



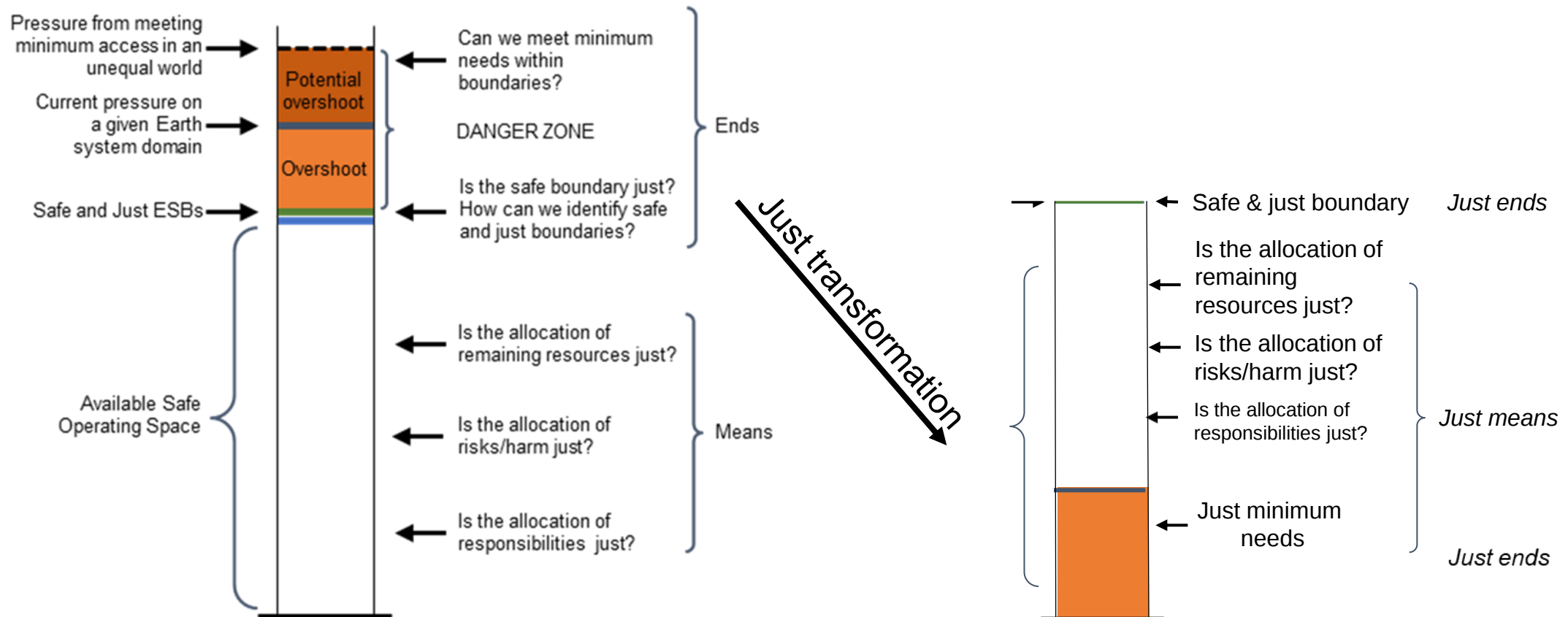
Many local ESBs are breached



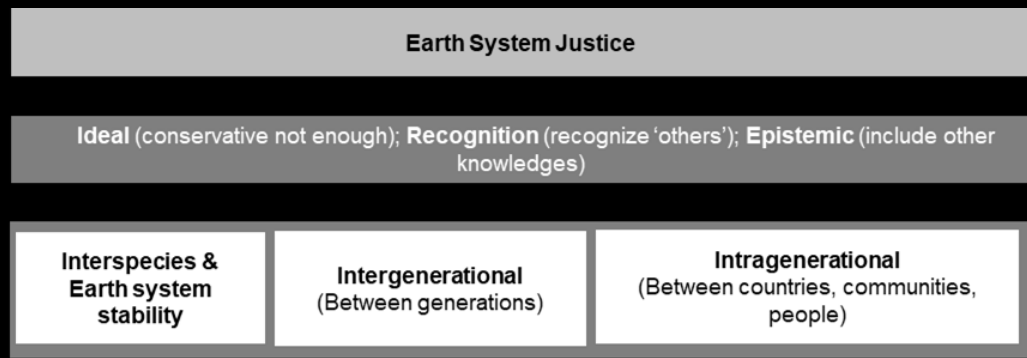
**At least two

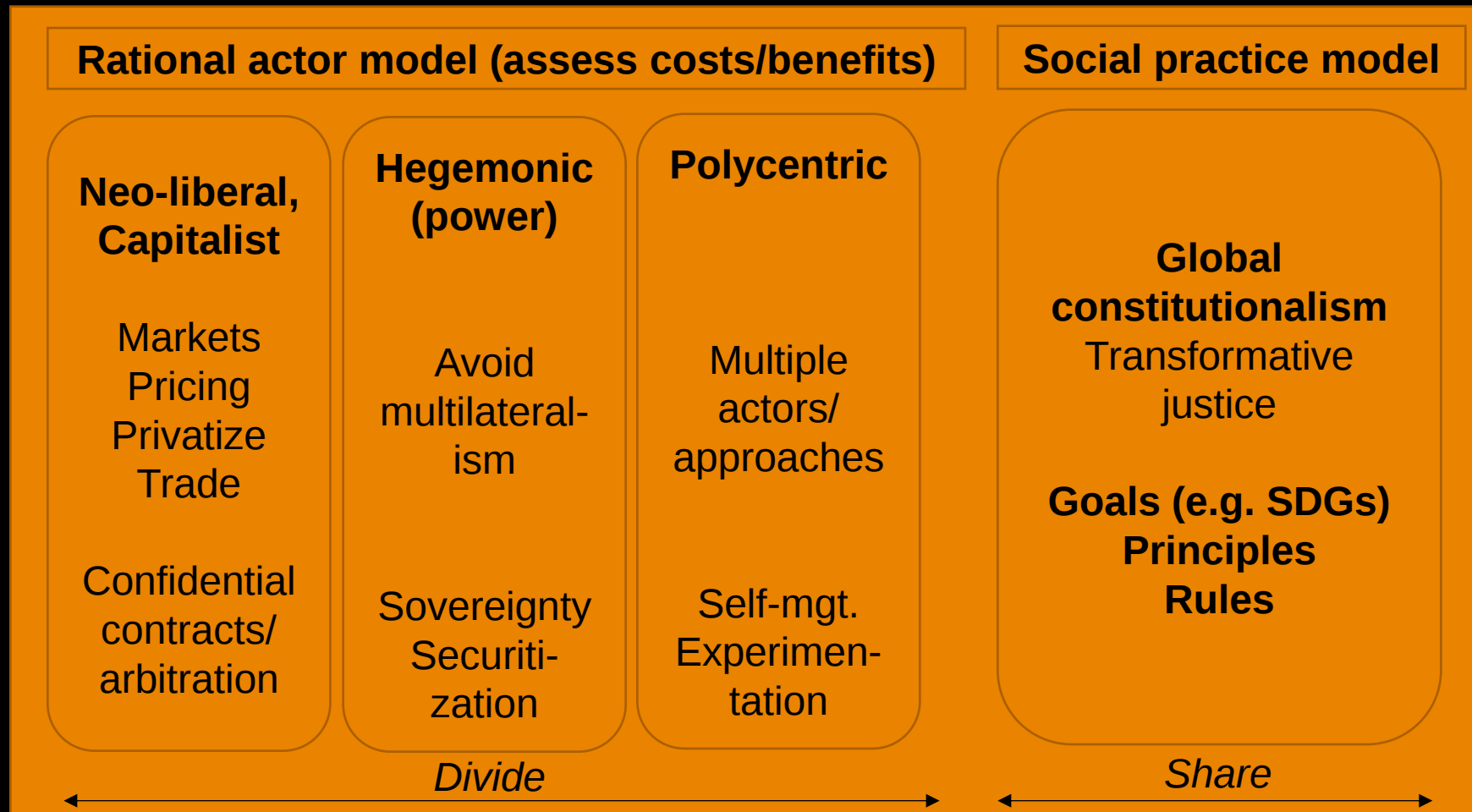

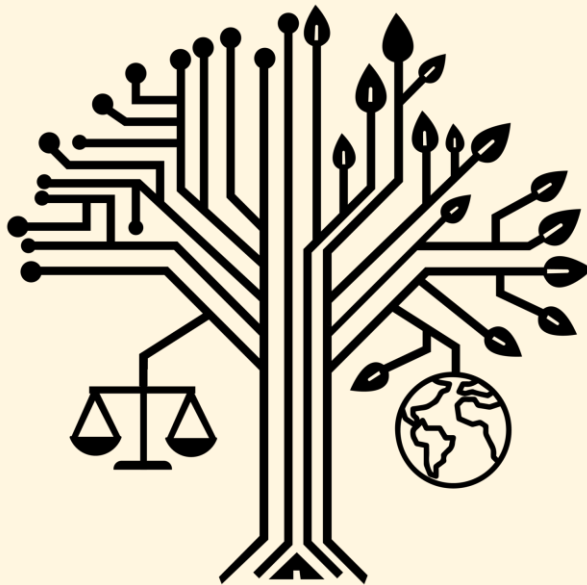
