THE LIVING PLANET INDEX

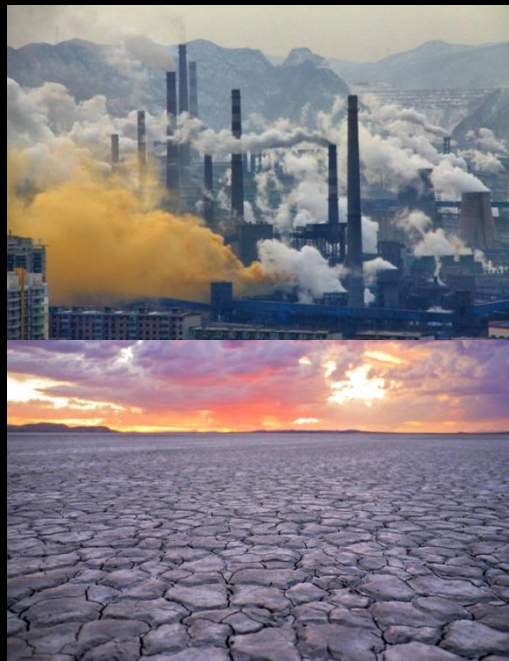


Global warming & Biodiversity loss 1970-2018
